

# Michigan & Mackinaw Island

## September 14-19, 2008

**Sunday, September 14** - Depart **York** via deluxe, video-equipped motorcoach. This evening we will check in to our hotel in Dearborn, Michigan. **Dinner & a Tour** of the home of an Auto-Baron are included this evening. See first hand how the auto pioneers lived – the graciousness, culture and hobbies they enjoyed. Experience a bygone era at this historically acclaimed architectural masterpiece.

**Monday, September 15**– Start with **Breakfast** before departing for the extraordinary **Henry Ford Museum** for our guided tour. Among many antique vehicles, we will see the car JFK was riding when assassinated in Dallas, plus the chair where Abraham Lincoln sat when killed in Ford's Theater. We then depart for Mackinac City where we'll enjoy a two-night stay. After we check into our beautiful waterfront resort, complete with indoor and outdoor pools, you can look forward to a delightful outdoor **BBQ Dinner** at the hotel.

This evening, we will check in to our hotel in Traverse City and have a provided **Dinner** at a local restaurant.

**Thursday, September 18** - Enjoy a **Breakfast** at the Hotel before leaving for Holland. We will meet our guide in **Holland** for a guided tour of the area. This afternoon we will visit **Tulip Gardens, Delft Factory, and the Wooden Shoe Factory**, where you can talk with the artists as they mold, hand paint, and glaze Delftware in the old traditional manner. You can browse through the spacious gift shop and you can watch craftsman carve wooden shoes on machines imported from the Netherlands. This is also Holland's only tulip farm. **Lunch** today is included. Next, we will visit **Windmill Island** and the **DeZwaan Windmill**. This 240-year-old treasure was dismantled in the Netherlands and restored to its original beauty on Windmill Island. From atop DeZwaan you can look out over 36 acres of manicured gardens, dikes and canals to the Fresian horses grazing in the pasture. Costumed guides, Amsterdam street organ, hand-painted Dutch carousel, and gift shops will complete your visit. After checking in to our local hotel, we will have **Dinner** at a local restaurant.

**Friday, September 19** - Enjoy **Breakfast** before departing for home with memories of a great trip!
