ITINERARY:

Thurs June 18 - Fairbanks

Flight to Fairbanks. Whether you're exploring Alaska's Golden Heart City or the wonderful amenities your hotel has to offer, get ready for an unforgettable journey in the days ahead. Please note the standard hotel check-in time is 3:00 pm. Enjoy the rest of your day at leisure.

Fri June 19 - Fairbanks

Your NCL Tour Director will greet you at your Fairbanks hotel. This morning, board your deluxe motor coach for a city tour of Fairbanks. Then onto the historic Gold Dredge #8 where you will get the chance to do some gold panning. Open afternoon and evening to explore Fairbanks or take an optional tour

Sat June 20 - Fairbanks/Denali

This morning, travel along the Alaska Railroad to Denali National Park with 360-degree views from your deluxe dome railcar seats. Be watchful for wildlife during your rail journey. Full bar and meal service are available for purchase during your rail journey. After lunch on your own, your tour includes the Tundra Wilderness Tour. You will travel to Denali National Park, enjoying the incredible scenery and some of the best opportunities to see wildlife in its natural setting. A light snack is included on the tour.

Sun June 21 - Denali/Anchorage

This morning is open for optional activities in Denali before heading out to learn about the Alaska state sport of dog mushing with an included stop at a local Iditarod sled dog kennel. Travel by motor coach to the town of Talkeetna and then, you'll take your second segment along the rails of the Alaska Railroad from Talkeetna to Anchorage in a deluxe dome railcar. Be watchful for wildlife, as well as glimpses of Mt. Denali, or, as the Alaskans call it, "The Great One." Full bar and meal service are available for purchase during your rail journey.

Mon June 22 - Anchorage/Whittier

This morning, enjoy a brief city tour of Anchorage and then continue south down the Turnagain Arm along the Seward Highway. This "All-American Scenic Highway" has spectacular views of the Cook Inlet and Chugach Mountains. Stop at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center and get up close to moose, bears, musk ox and other indigenous animals of the region. Continue on by motorcoach to Whittier to board Norwegian Jade for your 7-day Alaska cruise. Embark and set sail this afternoon at 4:00pm.

Tues June 23 - Hubbard Glacier, Alaska - scenic cruising
